

# Panhandle South Plains Lutheran Camp Association Camper Covenant Conduct Form

This camp covenant is our commitment to each other for how we will act, interact, and react during the entire camp experience in a God pleasing manner.

- 1. We agree to honor one another as members of God's family during the church camp experience by treating each other in the following Christian manner:
  - Show concern for others' physical and emotional well-being.
  - Use words that "build people up."
  - By using "welcoming traditions" that would glorify God in thought, word, and deed according to Luther's explanation of the fifth commandment stating that we should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical (and emotional) need
  - Have a positive attitude and be flexible when things go wrong or schedules change.
  - Understand that leaders will sometimes make decisions that we don't like but we will be supportive anyway. (When in doubt see point #2)
- 2. We agree to care for each other at camp by helping each other in these ways:
  - Offering to carry luggage, open doors, or assist with any job (sometimes even before being asked).
  - Be on time for meetings, so we don't hold everyone up.
  - Be considerate of shared space such as dorms and sleep time.
  - Be respectful of any other campers' property, camp property or anything else that is thy neighbor's.
- 3. We agree that we are called to be responsible to one another, the families and churches we represent, therefore we will deal with these behavior issues in the following ways:
  - With members of the opposite sex, we will show respect and follow Biblical guidelines for Christian conduct always being concerned for the other person's reputation, feelings, and well-being. (Keep it clean! Appropriate public display of affection only.)
  - Opposite genders will not be in dorms without the direct supervision of a staff member.
  - When we are angry, hassled, or upset we will talk to the person(s) involved (Matthew 18) or seek the help of an adult in resolving a problem.
  - We will refrain from smoking or the use of any tobacco product.
  - We will not engage in substance abuse of any kind including alcohol.
  - We will refrain from drinking energy drinks of any type.
  - We will use common sense and Christian care when an issue is not covered by this covenant.
  - We will refrain from using music that is offensive in any way in any format including personal headphones or music publicly heard.
  - In consideration for our own safety and in respect of our interactions with others, we

willingly agree to refrain from using cell phones while at camp.

- 4. In addition, we expect our camp staff members to:
  - Follow the same rules we have to follow.
  - Show patience and try to get the "whole story" before reacting.
  - Show a lighthearted, loving, fun side to themselves.
  - Consult campers in making decisions whenever appropriate with regard to activities.
  - Follow this covenant fairly in dealing with any & all problems.
- 5. In this covenant, we willingly agree to abide by these expectations:
  - Full participation in all scheduled camp events.
  - Full cooperation with any and all camp staff.
- 6. We agree to be appropriately dressed for all events:
  - We will not, at any time wear shirts that reveal the midriff area.
  - We will not, at any time wear shorts or pants that reveal the backside or underwear.
  - We will not wear shirts that show inappropriate words. For all swimming opportunities and events, swimming suits will be accepted as the only exception to this dress code.
  - Parents are expected to encourage their youth towards modest swimsuits. <u>Girls: Be prepared to wear a t-shirt over swimming apparel if your midriff shows!</u>
- 7. When someone refuses to follow this covenant, we will handle the problem with the following consequences.
  - You may be asked to consult privately with the Camp staffers or other youth involved in the problem.
  - You may be asked to spend part or all of the day under the direct supervision of an adult leader with no choices in activities.
  - For serious infractions of this covenant there will be NO TOLERANCE allowed. These infractions include <u>alcoholic beverage consumption or tobacco use of any kind, fornication, hazing, and/or bullying, or anything punishable as a misdemeanor or felony, and/or repeated lesser violations of this covenant. This no tolerance policy means that parents will be notified immediately regardless of the time of day or night. Parents will then have up to 4 hours to secure first available transportation home at parents' expense or inconvenience and camper will depart camp within a reasonable amount of time as agreed upon by the Camp Director.</u>
  - Camper(s) breaking any part of the Covenant, or acting in any way that the Camp Director feels to be inappropriate, may be asked to leave camp without receiving a camp refund.
